



Spring Birdhouse Tablerunner

9" x 28 ½" approx.

Fabric is "birds of a feather"
By Gail Pan Designs for Henry Glass and Co

Requirements:

- 1 fat eighth 9" x 21" red tossed birds
- 2 ½" x 18 "grey floral fabric
- 1 fat eighth 9" x 21" border stripe fabric
- 3" red vine fabric (binding)
- 1 rectangle 11" x 31" each batting and backing

Cutting:

Red tossed birds fabric: 5 rectangles 9" x 3 ½"
Grey floral fabric: 2 rectangles 9" x 2 ½"
Red vine fabric: 2 strips 1 ½" x width of fabric (binding)
border stripe fabric: 2 rectangles 9" x 5" Fussy cut these two with the birdhouse in the centre and the grey birds each side facing in. Cut ¼" each side of the red word strip and the green word strip. This may slightly be smaller than 5".

Sewing:

Sew the strips together using the picture as a guide.
All seams are ¼".

Layer and quilt. I have quilted a wavy line in the middle of each strip, except for the birdhouse strip.

Binding:

Bind with the red vine strips. (single fold binding)
